REVISION TO ARTERIAL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND TRAFFIC MONITORING CAMERA SYSTEM PROVISION FOR ARTERIAL ROAD

New framework for carrying out Arterial Traffic Management System (ATMS) and Traffic Monitoring Camera System (TMCS) field equipment works affected by development/projects

1. We would like to inform the industry that Land Transport Authority (LTA) has appointed the following contractors as LTA Appointed Contractors (LACs) to facilitate requestors who require relocation of ATMS and TMCS field equipment affected by their project or development works to engage the LAC to carry out the affected relocation works.

2. The new framework will allow the requestors to make direct payment to the LAC with flexibility in commercial agreement and simplified coordination without going through LTA, while ensuring the quality of works which will comply with LTA specifications.
3. Effective from 6th October 2025, you will be required to inform LTA of your works and engage the LAC through an Agreement to carry out ATMS and/or TMCS field equipment works affected by the project or development.

4. Requestor shall provide the necessary information (e.g. site drawings) to the LAC to facilitate their preparation of documents to seek approval from LTA for changes in the equipment layout. Thereafter, the LAC shall seek LTA's approval on the changes in the equipment layout design before providing a quotation for your approval and confirmation of the Agreement.
5. The Agreement shall broadly cover the estimated value of the relocation works reference to the LTA term contract rates with a 10% administrative charge, payment terms and works schedule. Any changes to the Agreement shall be mutually agreed by both parties.
6. Upon completion of the works, the requestor shall check the works and pay the LAC for the works done in accordance with the terms and conditions in the Agreement.
7. The terms and conditions to be included in the Agreement is as shown in Appendix A for reference.

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Appendix A:

Terms and Conditions to Be Included in the Agreement between External Party and LAC

1. The agreement between *[External Party]* and *[LAC]* shall constitute an independent contract. For the avoidance of doubt:

- a) *[LAC]* and *[External Party]* shall agree to the Quotation and the payment terms indicated.

- b) Any changes in the value and scope of the Quotation due to unforeseen circumstance (e.g. site constraints) shall be agreeable upon by all parties in writing after a joint meeting.
- c) The *[the External Party]* and *[LAC]* shall adhere to the work schedule as agreed.

Works Commencement	Works Completion

- d) Any changes to the work schedule shall be agreed upon by both parties in writing.
 - e) Upon completion of the Ad-Hoc Works by *[LAC]*, *[LAC]* and the *[External Party]* shall jointly arrange a 3-party joint inspection with the Authority to obtain acceptance of the Ad-Hoc Works.
 - f) *[LAC]* shall be liable to rectify any defects or non-compliance to the Authority's approved design picked up during the joint inspection.
 - g) After the Authority's acceptance of the Ad-Hoc Works, the *[External Party]* and *[LAC]* shall reach agreement with on the final costs of works and settle the payment directly for the Ad-Hoc Works.
 - h) Disputes, including disputes over delay, shall be settled with reference to the terms of the agreement entered between *[External Party]* and *[LAC]*.
2. *[External Party]* shall be responsible for coordinating with relevant parties (such as NParks, PUB, Telcos, SP Group etc) to provide approval for site works due to presence of trees, drainage infrastructure, underground utility and telecommunication services etc and SPPG for payment, provision, test and commissioning of power supply (where applicable) for the Ad-Hoc Works.
 3. Unless otherwise expressly stated in this agreement, a person who is not a party to this agreement shall have no right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 2001 to enforce any of its terms.
